

Martin OM-21 000 1933 Acoustic Guitar in Ambertone

The Martin OM-21 was introduced in 1929 and ceased production at the end of 1933 as the OM (OM stands for orchestral model )

This re-imagined Martin OM-21 is in high gloss Ambertone, which is based on the original Martin "Shaded Top finish "offered by Martin at that time on a special order basis.

The original 30's OM-21 had an ebony fingerboard and bridge, were 14 fret to the body, had open back Grover tuners, scolloped X bracing, Sitka spruce top with Rosewood back and sides.

This Re-Imagined OM-21 in high gloss Ambertone has all of the Original features of its predecessor from the 1930's plus the more modern low profile neck. This particular guitar has a book matched, highly figured Rosewood back, which is a bit of a plus! (See Pictures below)

An original OM-21 is a highly collectable vintage guitar valued by collectors around the world. Martin have as they say reinvented a classic from their heyday of the 1930's.

This guitar is in "as new condition" and priced well below its r.r.p Comes in its original Martin hard shell case, and original Martin hang tags.
